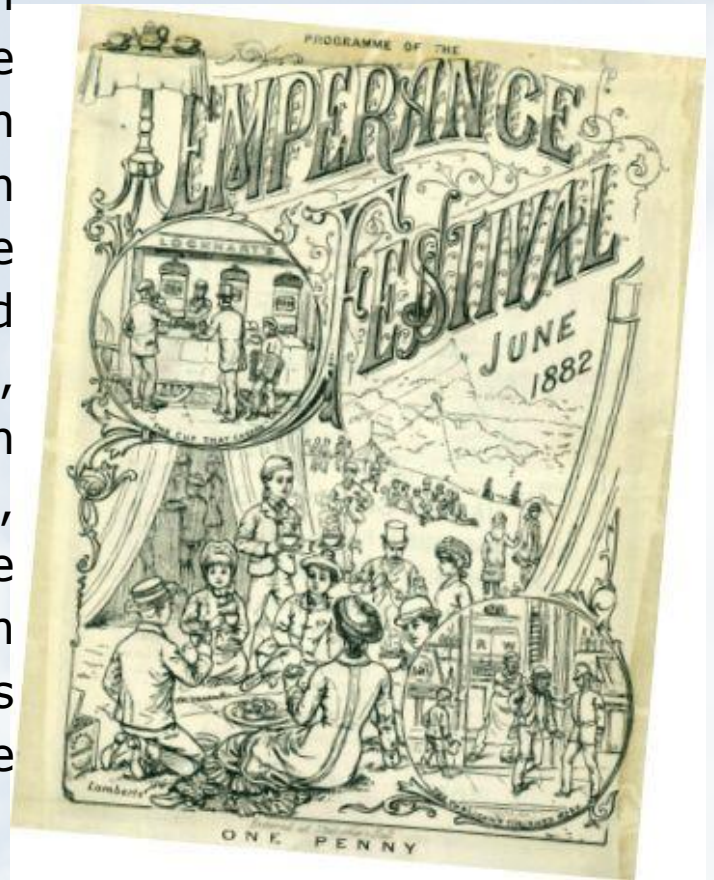
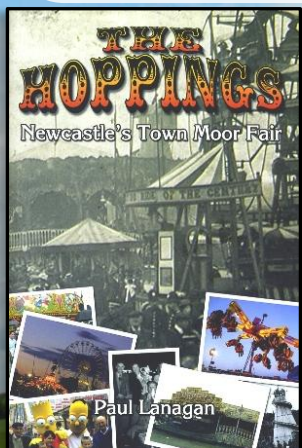


# TEMPERANCE FESTIVAL 1882
